The application deadline for the two \$2,500 PRSA Puget Sound scholarships is rapidly approaching. The Sally Heet Memorial Scholarship and the Horace and Sally Revels Cayton Scholarship are awarded annually to students who are entering their junior or senior years and are pursuing careers in public relations.

If you know of a student who is eligible, encourage them to apply before the April 17, 2012 deadline under the Students section of the **PRSA Puget Sound** website. Because both scholarship applications require transcripts, students should leave one to two weeks to complete all of the requirements.
